Memo to Providers

Communicable Disease (CD) Reporting

January 2020

During our normal working hours (Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., closed on all major holidays):

1. To report an **“immediate”** or **“within 24 hours”** CD, call (541) 266-6700 and ask for a CD staff member.
2. To report a **“within one working day”** CD, fax the report to our confidential fax at **(541) 888-8726**.

After our normal working hours: (Monday through Friday, 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m., Sat, Sun)

1. To report an **“immediate”** CD, call the Coos County Sheriff’s dispatch, **(541) 396-2106**. If you do not receive a response from a public health professional within 30 minutes, call the Sheriff’s dispatch, again. If you still do not get a response, call the Oregon Acute and Communicable Disease after-hours number, (971) 673-1111, and ask to speak with the state epidemiologist on call.
2. To report a **“within 24 hours”** CD, call the Coos County Sheriff’s dispatch, **(541) 396-2106**. If you do not receive a response from a public health professional within 30 minutes, call the Sheriff’s dispatch, again. If you still do not get a response, call the Oregon Acute and Communicable Disease after-hours number, (971) 673-1111, and ask to speak with the state epidemiologist on call.
3. To report a **“within one working day”** CD, fax the report to our confidential fax at **(541)-888-8726**.
