Who should get tested?

- You should get tested if you have symptoms of COVID-19.
- You should be tested if you have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive with COVID-19. Close contact means being within six feet of someone for 15 minutes or more over the course of a day, with or without a mask or face covering. It's best if you wait three to four days after you were together before taking a test.

El contacto cercano significa estar a seis pies de alguien durante 15 minutos o más en el transcurso de un día, con o sin mascarilla rrilla o cubierta facial. Se recomienda hacerse el test después de tres a cuatro días de haber estado en contacto.

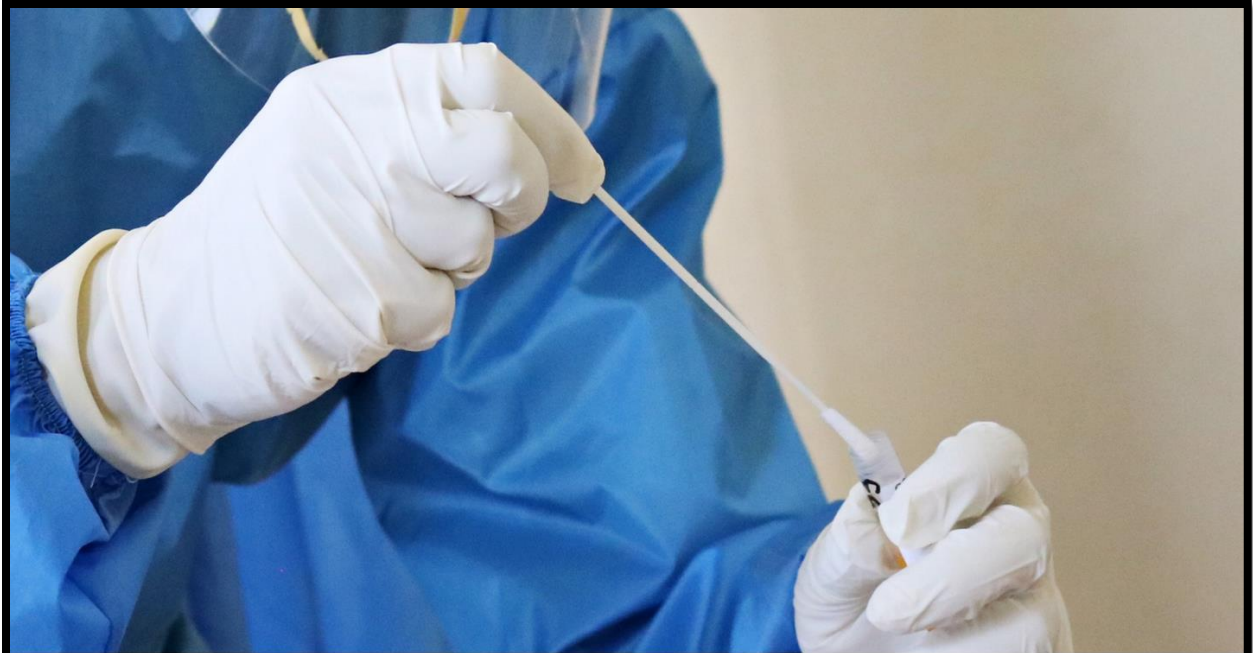
