What are these programs?

Public Health nurses and community health workers partner closely with enrolled families to make sure moms, babies, young children, teens and caregivers have the support and information they need to be healthy.

We offer longer-term, relationship-based services that strive to reduce the gap in health and racial inequity by meeting their needs.

Services are provided in the comfort of your home (or at a location of your choosing), are **voluntary**, and are provided at **no cost** to eligible Coos County residents.

CaCoon

When children and youth get health care and services from a number of different sources, it's important that all the moving parts work well together.

CaCoon program provides "CAre COordinatiON" for children (ages birth to 21 years of age) with special health needs and their families. One in 5 children in Oregon fits this description.

CaCoon nurses partner with you to:

- Become as independent as possible in caring for your special needs child
- Identify your child's strengths and needs
- Clarify problems and find solutions
- Explore resources and services to best meet your child's unique needs
- Identify ways to maximize your child's potential at home, at school, and as part of the community
- Link you to specialty health care and community resources as appropriate
- Support and advocate for you and your child to obtain needed services
- Coordinate with other health and community partners so care is more effective and efficient
- Prepare for the transition from pediatric to adult health care, work, and independence

Babies First!

Babies First! offers services to pregnant women and families with babies and young children up to age 5 years.

Babies First! offers a wide range of services such as:

- Helping to solve problems, reduce stress, and connect to services you might need
- Serving as your personal parenting coach to strengthen & expand your parenting skills
- Helping you support your child's growth & development
- Providing periodic developmental screenings for your child
- Supporting and building a happy, loving relationship with your child
- Sharing home safety tips as your child grows
- Providing referrals and consultation with medical care and other services
