Concerned about a child's health or development? We can help!

Have you wished everyone had a more complete picture of the child you live or interact with? Have you ever wished your child's doctor knew more about what went on at school or that the teacher new more about your child's health? Your local Child Health Team can help put these pieces together.

There might be a number of things affecting a child's health or development. The Child Health Team looks at the whole picture and brings families together with people from health, school, and community services. If there are unmet needs, the Child Health Team will work with you on a plan to get those needs met.





What will the Child Health Team do?

- The team doctor will evaluate the child or review medical records and talk with your child's doctor
- Schedule a team meeting with child/family, health, school, and other providers. At this meeting, we talk about how the child is doing at home, school, and in the community and how we can help meet the child's needs
- Develop a shared plan of care to address the child's needs
- · Make referrals to specialists, if needed
- Connect families with information, resources, and support
- Schedule a follow up team meeting to ensure goals are getting met

How can I request a Child Health Team meeting?

Anyone can request Child Health Team meeting including parents, caregivers, teachers, doctors, therapists, and others.

Who is eligible?

The Child Health Team serves children ages birth up to 21 years with special health needs (physical, emotional, cognitive, or behavioral health concerns) who live in Coos, Curry, and Coastal Douglas Counties.

There is no cost to families seeking Child Health Team services.
